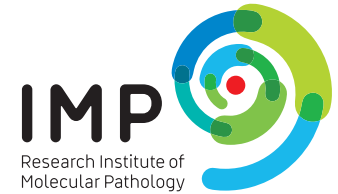


# Master in Neuroscience
